



This dart above is sewn $\frac{3}{8}$ " from fold at waist, and is 5" long.

I sew parallel to fold line to just below the waist seam line, and then begin the outside curve, which continues to about $\frac{1}{2}$ inch shy of the dart point, and then it makes a straight taper to the point.

This size dart does not poke out too bad on finished garment, but one that is sewn $\frac{5}{8}$ inch from dart fold does poke out. (shown below)
