

Fabric: solids, plaids, checks; must be alike on both sides - 54" - 60" square.

Fringe: 6 yards braid or fringe for outer edge; must be stitched to both sides of cape.

Armhole Slashes: 11/2 yards double fold braid.

Fig. A. Pull threads and straighten all four sides of square.

Fig. B. Fold in half lengthwise and crosswise grain of fabric.

Fig. C. Mark center point with a pin. With an extended string and a piece of chalk, draw and cut a circle.

Fig. D. Refold circle by bringing 1X to 2X as shown in sketch to obtain true bias.

Important: The garment will not have a flowing effect if worn on straight grain.

Fig. E. Measure each side of center point 8" and cut a slash 41/2" deep, slightly curved.
