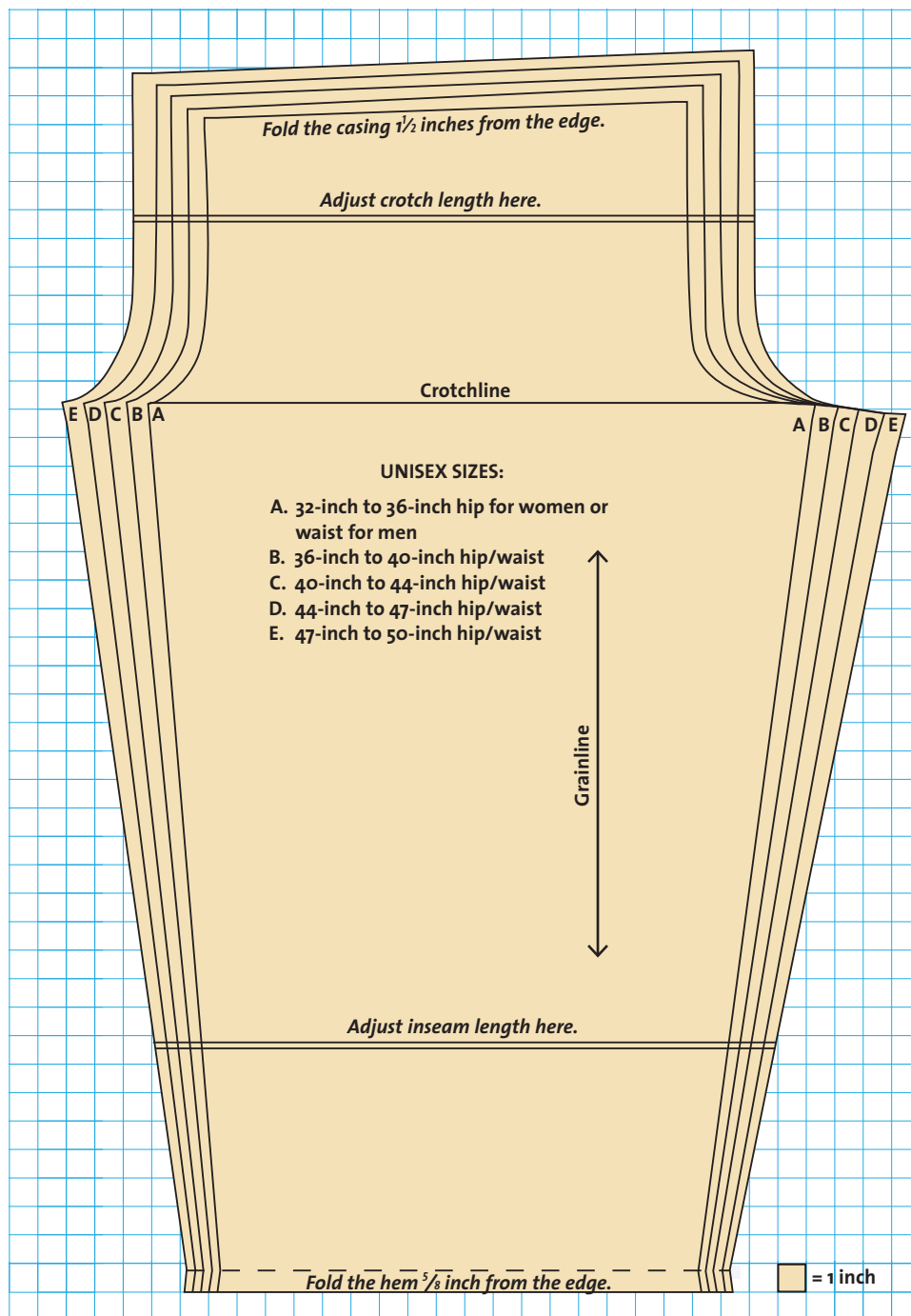


# Easy PJs Pattern



Enlarge this pattern 640 percent or until the squares measure 1 inch. Lengthen or shorten the pattern on the double lines.



## To alter this pattern for children:

1. Subtract the child's hip or waist measurement, whichever is larger, from the pattern's size A hip/waist measurement.
2. Fold the pant pattern vertically, parallel to the grainline. Fold out half the circumference difference (from step 1). This establishes the pants' circumference.
3. Have the child sit on a hard chair, and measure vertically from the seat to the waist. Add 1 inch to this crotch depth measurement. Shorten the pattern to make the distance between the upper edge and crotchline equal this measurement plus 1/2 inches.
4. Measure the child's inseam. Shorten the pattern where marked so the distance from the crotchline to the hem foldline equals this length.
